### ST. MARY MAGDALEN PARISH EDUCATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SCHOOL YEAR 2010-2011

Through the Sacrificial Gifts of the parishioners of St. Mary Magdalen, limited tuition assistance is available to eligible students of St. Mary Magdalen School, Early Learning Center and Bishop Moore High School. This tuition assistance is a sign of the parish community's commitment to support the ministry of Catholic Education. In order to discern true need, we have enlisted SMART Tuition Aid Analysis to assist us in determining which students/families enrolled in St. Mary Magdalen School, St. Mary Magdalen Early Learning Center or Bishop Moore High School are eligible for limited financial assistance. Recommendations of this agency will serve as a basis for allocation of funds available to the program. Due to the limited amount of funds available, the parish will first consider those whose household incomes are \$50,000 or less. If monies are available, then those with greater incomes will be considered.

Financial aid is available for St. Mary Magdalen Parish families who have made the commitment to be Partners in the Mission (see back of flyer for information). Students/families must also have completed registration applications on file at either St. Mary Magdalen School, Early Learning Center or Bishop Moore High School for the 2010-2011 school year. No scholarship requests will be considered without the submission of the completed financial aid form, including tax documentation. Completed applications (with supporting documents) are due no later than 4:00 p.m. Friday, March 12, 2010 to SMART Tuition Aid Analysis, in order to be considered for financial assistance for the 2010-2011 School Year. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Completed forms must include a copy of your 2009 Federal Income Tax Return, as specified on the first page of the application, and a check made payable to SMART Tuition Aid Analysis in the amount of \$20.00 to cover external processing costs. Credit card payments will also be accepted.
