* **From Orlando Int'l. Airport:** Go north on SR 436, turn right onto Howell Branch Road. Turn left on Dike Road (second light). San Pedro is 0.7 miles on the left. Total travel distance: 12-13 miles.

* **From I-4:** Take I-4 to the Lee Road exit, take Lee east to where it ends on 17-92. Turn left onto 17-92, proceed 1.5 miles then turn right onto Horatio. Horatio becomes Howell Branch. Cross SR 436 and turn left on Dike Road (second light). San Pedro is 0.7 miles on the left. **Note:** Total travel distance on Horatio/Howell Branch is 4.3 miles.

Why the name “Emmaus”?

Emmaus is the name of the town where the resurrected Jesus was revealed to two of His followers in Luke 24:13-35.

How Did Emmaus Begin?

The Emmaus program was started in the early 1970s by a group of lay people with the help of the Sacred Heart Fathers. These people saw a need for the church to reach out to young adults. They wanted to share how important Christ had been in their lives. Today, the Emmaus program continues to meet this need by bringing Christ into the lives of many more young people.

What Is Emmaus?

Emmaus is a weekend retreat program for vibrant young adults (minimum age of 18), single or married, that are seeking to grow in their relationship with Christ, regardless of their present level of faith and practice. The purpose of the weekend is to give young adults an opportunity to reflect upon themselves and their relationship with God and community. Emmaus is a Catholic retreat program that is open to people of all Christian faiths and denominations.

Where and When Are Emmaus Retreats Held?

Emmaus retreats are held on the camp side of San Pedro Center in Winter Park, near Orlando. The retreat begins on Friday night at 7:00 p.m. and ends around 7:00 p.m. on Sunday night.

What Happens on an Emmaus Retreat?

The weekend consists of several spiritual talks and small group discussions led by various lay people and clergy. Many of these leaders are young people who have already experienced Emmaus. The format allows time for personal reflection, socializing, song, and even a few surprises! All this takes place in a warm, relaxed atmosphere.

Is There a Follow-up to Emmaus?

For those who wish to continue the experience, there is a follow-up to the Emmaus retreat called Galilee. Galilee meetings feature presentations, sharing and fellowship.

Emmaus Retreat Weekend April 29 to May 1, 2011

The registration fee is \$50.00. A \$25.00 advance deposit will reserve your space. This deposit is non-refundable, but may be applied to a future retreat. Early registration is encouraged since we are limited to thirty (30) candidates per retreat, and is open on a first come, first served basis. The price of the weekend includes lodging and all meals. If you need financial assistance with the registration fee please contact the Program Coordinator.

* *Note: Candidates are expected to stay at Camp San Pedro for the entire weekend.*
