

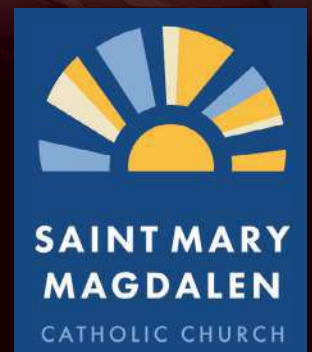

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

In this Sunday's First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles, we witness a pivotal moment in the life of the early Church. As the community grew, the Apostles recognized the need to ensure that no one was neglected, especially the most vulnerable. They appointed seven men of good reputation, filled with the Spirit and wisdom, to serve the needs of the people. This moment is understood as the beginning of the diaconate, a ministry born out of charity and service.

The very word deacon comes from the Greek diakonia, meaning "service." From the beginning, this vocation has been centered on caring for others, especially the poor, the widows and the orphans, and assisting the Apostles in their mission. In the early Church, deacons served as a vital bridge between the Apostles and the people, helping meet practical needs while supporting the life of the community. Today, deacons proclaim the Gospel, assist at the altar, preach, baptize, witness marriages, educate, and serve the needs of the poor and the marginalized.

We are blessed in our parish to have Deacon Juan and Deacon Tony, who faithfully live out this calling among us. Through their service at the altar and in our community, they help make Christ present in a unique and powerful way. We offer them our sincere gratitude for their generous "yes" to this vocation.

Let us also pray for the men currently in formation for the diaconate, that they may be strengthened in their calling and may more men in our community be open to discerning whether God is calling them to this beautiful vocation of service.

Mis hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En la Primera Lectura de este domingo, tomada de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, somos testigos de un momento decisivo en la vida de la Iglesia primitiva. A medida que la comunidad crecía, los Apóstoles reconocieron la necesidad de asegurarse de que nadie fuera descuidado, especialmente los más vulnerables. Por eso eligieron a siete hombres de buena reputación, llenos del Espíritu y de sabiduría, para atender las necesidades del pueblo. Este momento se entiende como el inicio del diaconado, un ministerio nacido de la caridad y el servicio.

La misma palabra "diácono" proviene del griego diakonia, que significa "servicio". Desde el principio, esta vocación ha estado centrada en el cuidado de los demás, especialmente de los pobres, las viudas y los huérfanos, y en asistir a los Apóstoles en su misión. En la Iglesia primitiva, los diáconos servían como un puente vital entre los Apóstoles y el pueblo, ayudando a responder a las necesidades prácticas mientras sostenían la vida de la comunidad. Hoy en día, los diáconos proclaman el Evangelio, asisten en el altar, predicán, bautizan, son testigos de matrimonios, educan y sirven a los pobres y a los marginados.

En nuestra parroquia somos bendecidos de contar con el Diácono Juan y el Diácono Tony, quienes viven fielmente este llamado entre nosotros. A través de su servicio en el altar y en nuestra comunidad, ayudan a hacer presente a Cristo de una manera única y poderosa. Les ofrecemos nuestra sincera gratitud por su generoso "sí" a esta vocación.

THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF THE PONTIFICATE OF HIS HOLINESS POPE LEO XIV



On May 8, 2025, the College of Cardinals elected Chicago-born Robert Francis Prevost as Pope Leo XIV, marking a historic moment as the first American to be named Supreme Pontiff. A naturalized citizen of Peru, the Holy Father brings a unique perspective to the papacy, his pastoral heart shaped by years of missionary service in South America. His election bridges his North American roots with a deep, lived commitment to the global Church.

FIRST BLESSING “URBI ET ORBI” OF HIS HOLINESS POPE LEO XIV THURSDAY, 8 MAY 2025

“Peace be with you all! Dear brothers and sisters, these are the first words spoken by the risen Christ, the Good Shepherd who laid down his life for God’s flock. I would like this greeting of peace to resound in your hearts, in your families, among all people, wherever they may be, in every nation and throughout the world. Peace be with you!

It is the peace of the risen Christ. A peace that is unarmed and disarming, humble and persevering. A peace that comes from God, the God who loves us all, unconditionally.

We can still hear the faint yet ever courageous voice of Pope Francis as he blessed Rome, the Pope who blessed Rome, who gave his blessing to the world, the whole world, on the morning of Easter. Allow me to extend that same blessing: God loves us, God loves you all, and evil will not prevail! All of us are in God’s hands. So, let us move forward, without fear, together, hand in hand with God and with one another other! We are followers of Christ. Christ goes before us. The world needs his light. Humanity needs him as the bridge that can lead us to God and his love. Help us, one and all, to build bridges through dialogue and encounter, joining together as one people, always at peace. Thank you, Pope Francis!

I also thank my brother Cardinals, who have chosen me to be the Successor of Peter and to walk together with you as a Church, united, ever pursuing peace and justice, ever seeking to act as men and women faithful to Jesus Christ, in order to proclaim the Gospel without fear, to be missionaries. I am an Augustinian, a son of Saint Augustine, who once said, “With you I am a Christian, and for you I am a bishop.” In this sense, all of us can journey together toward the homeland that God has prepared for us. A special greeting to the Church of Rome! Together, we must look for ways to be a missionary Church, a Church that builds bridges and encourages dialogue, a Church ever open to welcoming, like this Square with its open arms, all those who are in need of our charity, our presence, our readiness to dialogue and our love.”

HONORING THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY AND ALL MOTHERS IN MAY

May is traditionally dedicated in a special way to honoring and seeking the intercession of Mary as the Mother of God and Mother of the Church. “She is that woman who rejoiced in the presence of God, who treasured everything in her heart, and who let herself be pierced by the sword. Mary is the saint among the saints, blessed above all others. She teaches us the way of holiness, and she walks ever at our side. She does not let us remain fallen and at times she takes us into her arms without judging us.” — Pope Francis, *Gaudete et Exsultate*, no. 176

The tradition of dedicating the month of May to the Virgin Mary emerged in the 13th century. While some suggest it was established to replace ancient pagan rituals, its true essence lies in the peak of springtime beauty. As nature undergoes a season of renewal, the Church finds a natural parallel in Mary’s life-giving role. This devotion gained significant momentum through the Jesuit Order; by 1700, it was a staple of student life at the Roman College and was soon celebrated publicly at the Church of the Gesù in Rome. The practice radiated throughout the global Church. Today, Mary remains a cornerstone of Catholic identity—the ultimate model of a “Yes” to God’s will. Just as children turn to their mothers, the faithful seek her intercession during life’s most challenging trials.



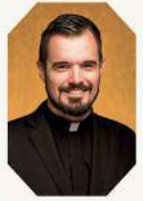
